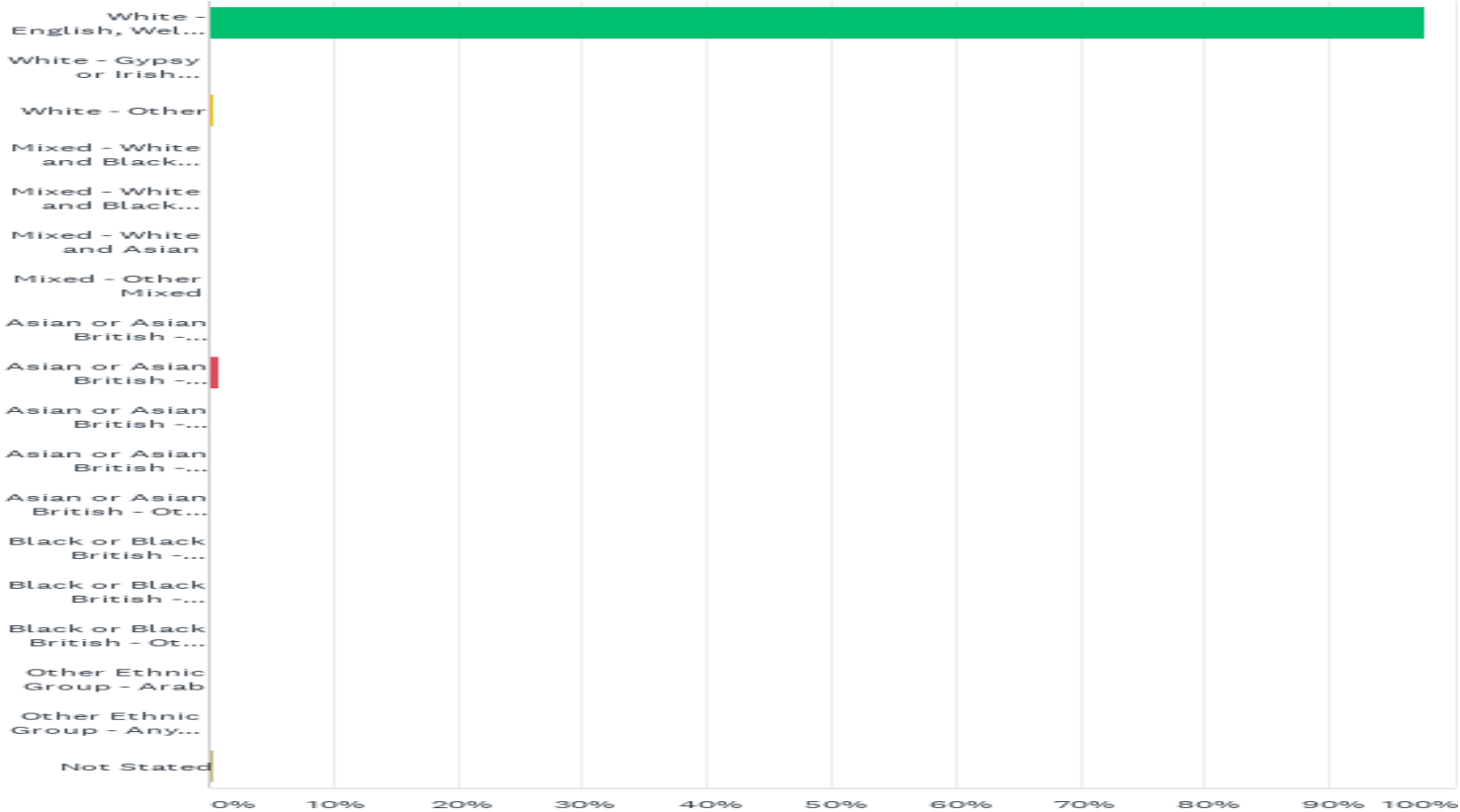

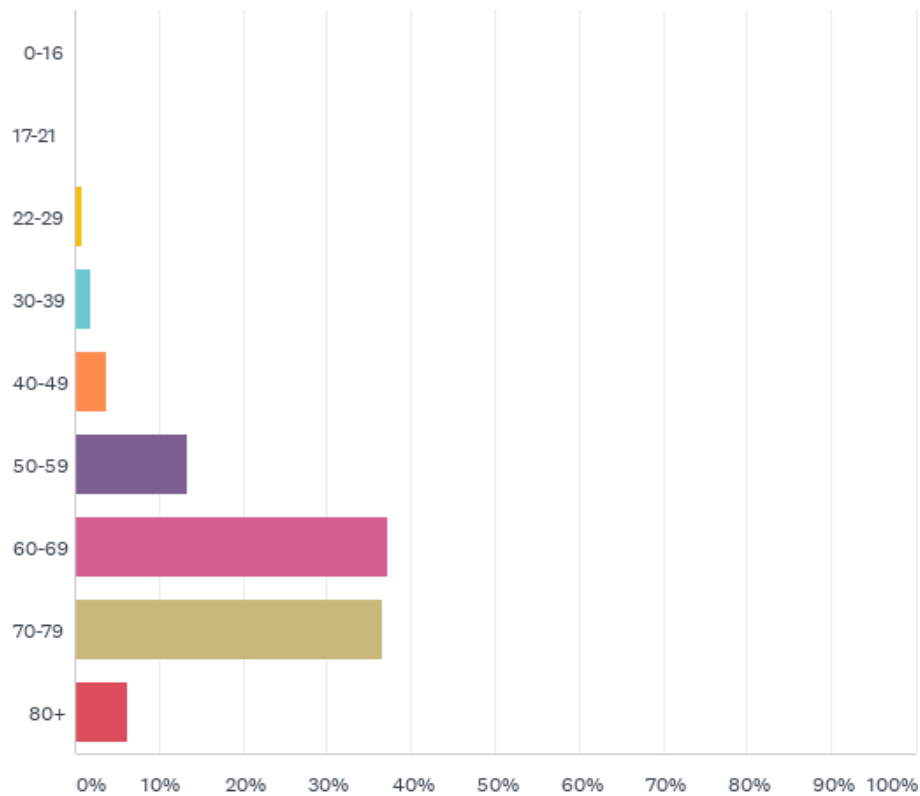
Q1: Which of the following options best describes how you think of yourself?



Q2: What is your ethnicity?

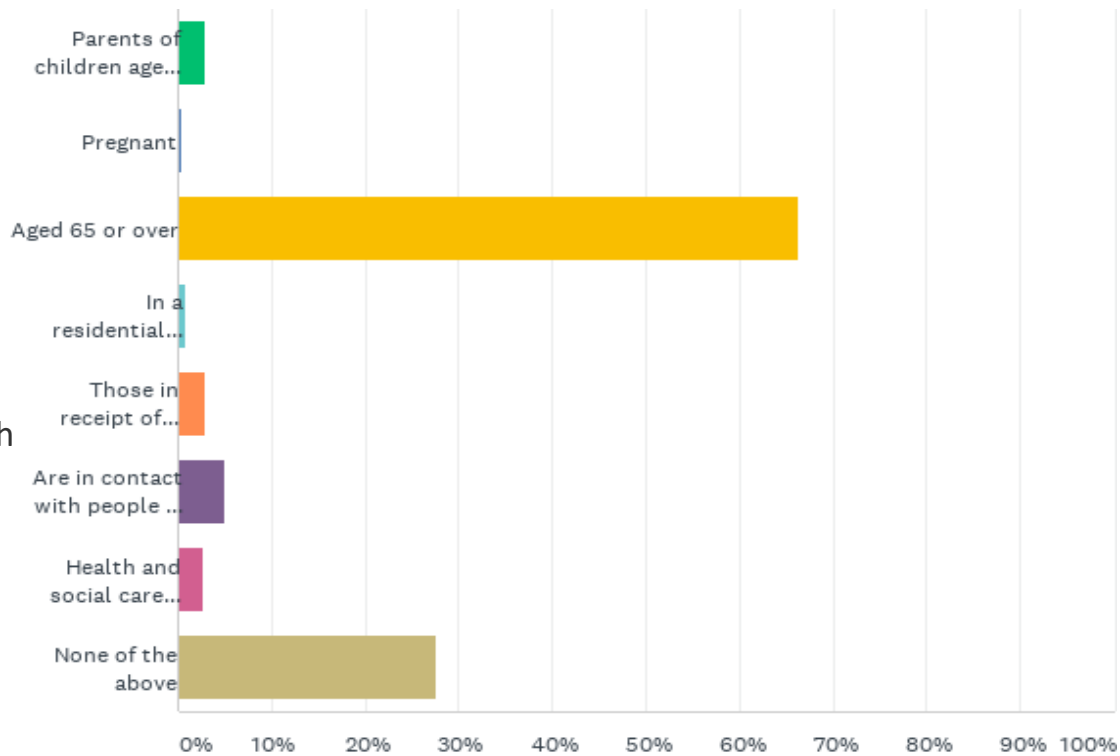


Q3: What is your age?



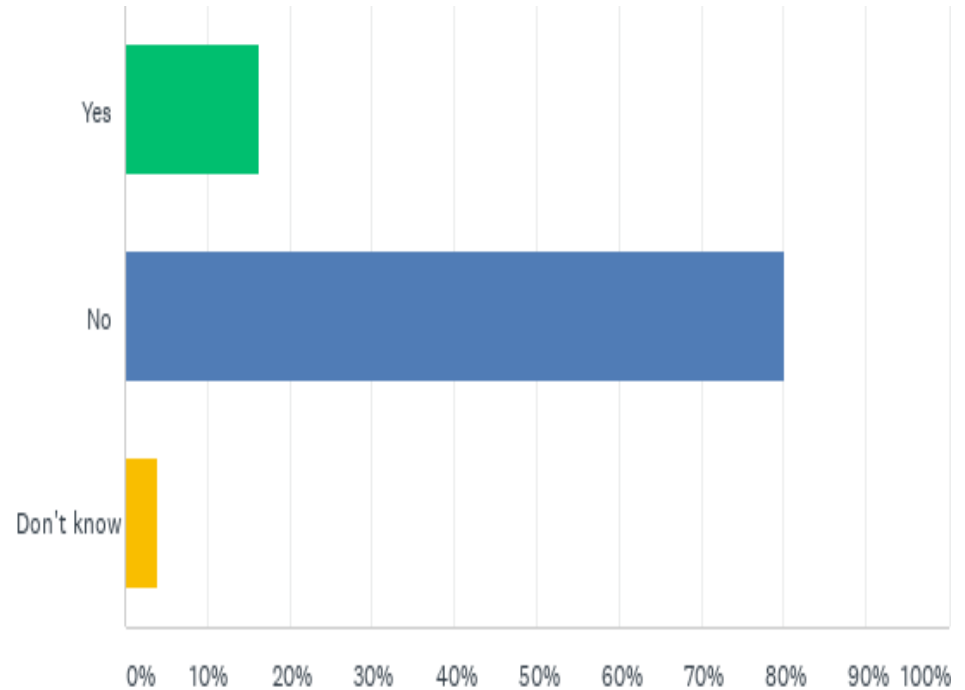
Q4: Do you fall into any of the below categories?

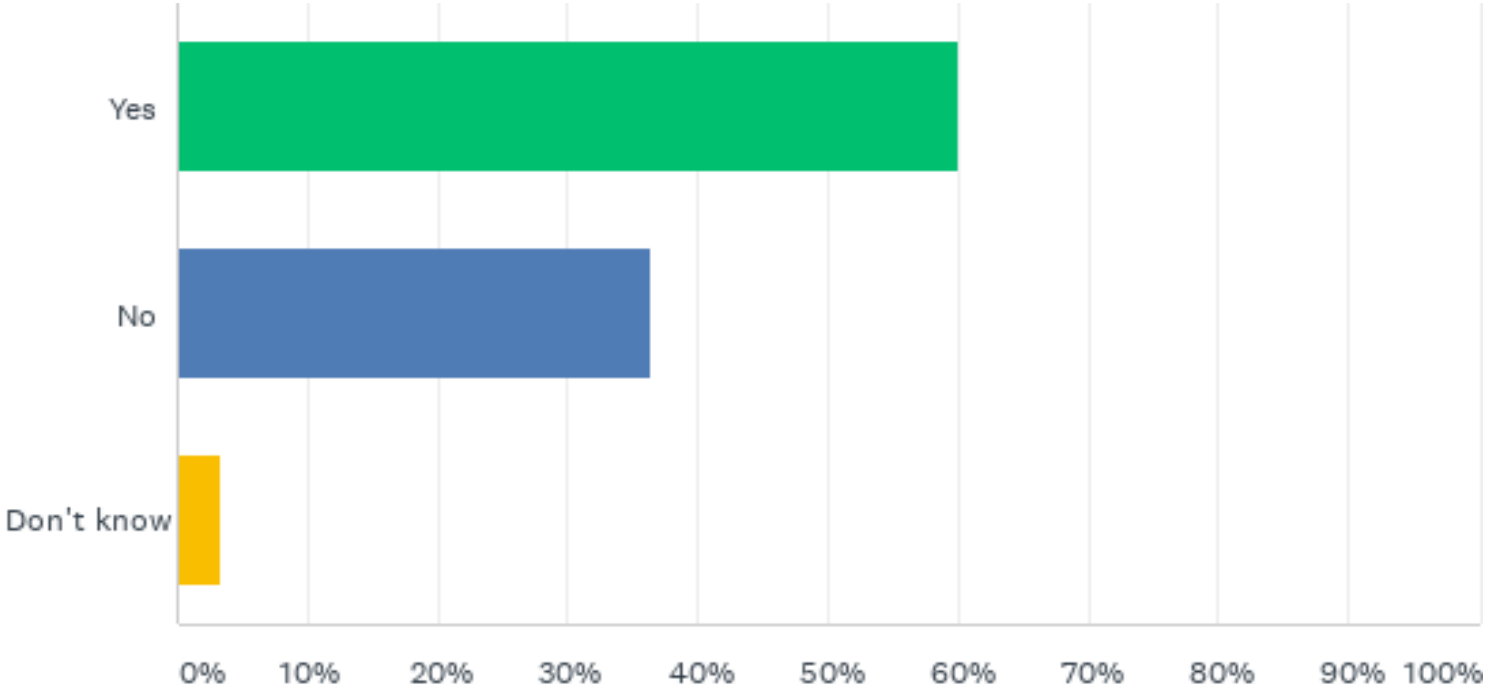

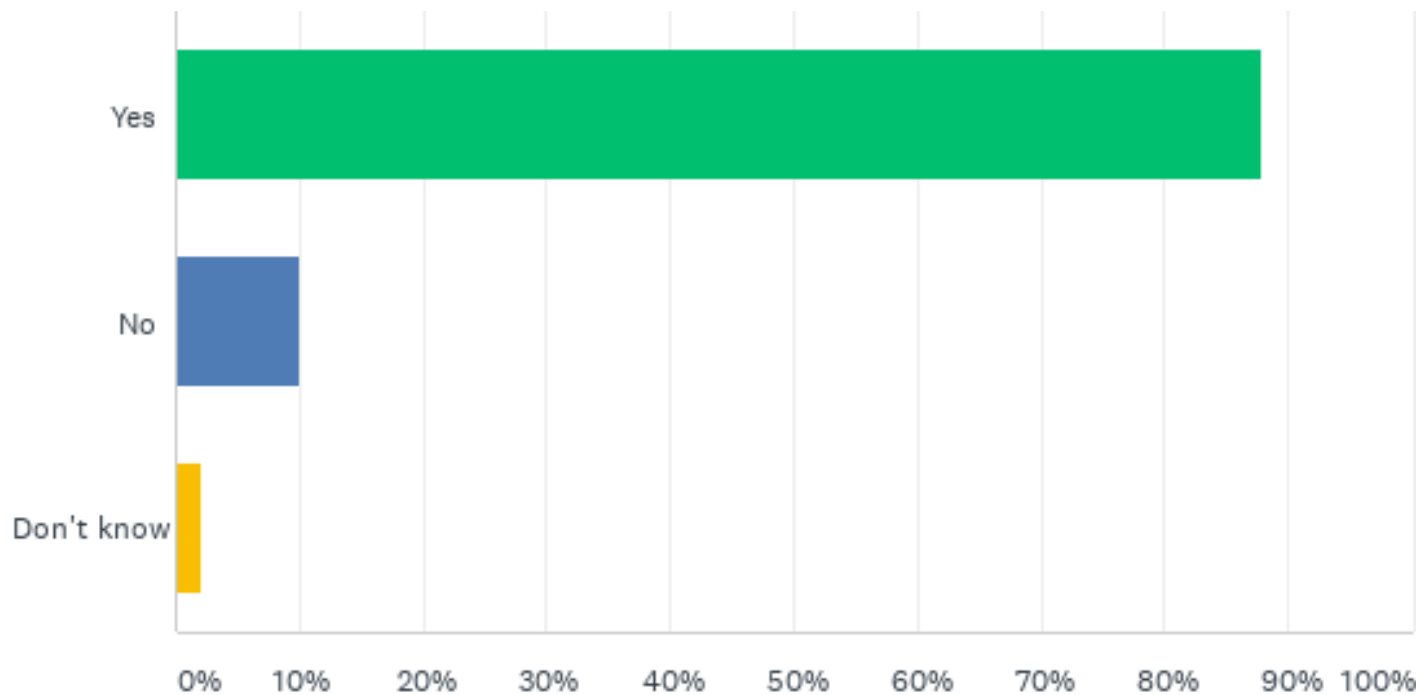
- Patients with Chronic Heart Disease**

- Patients with morbid obesity (BMI over 40)**



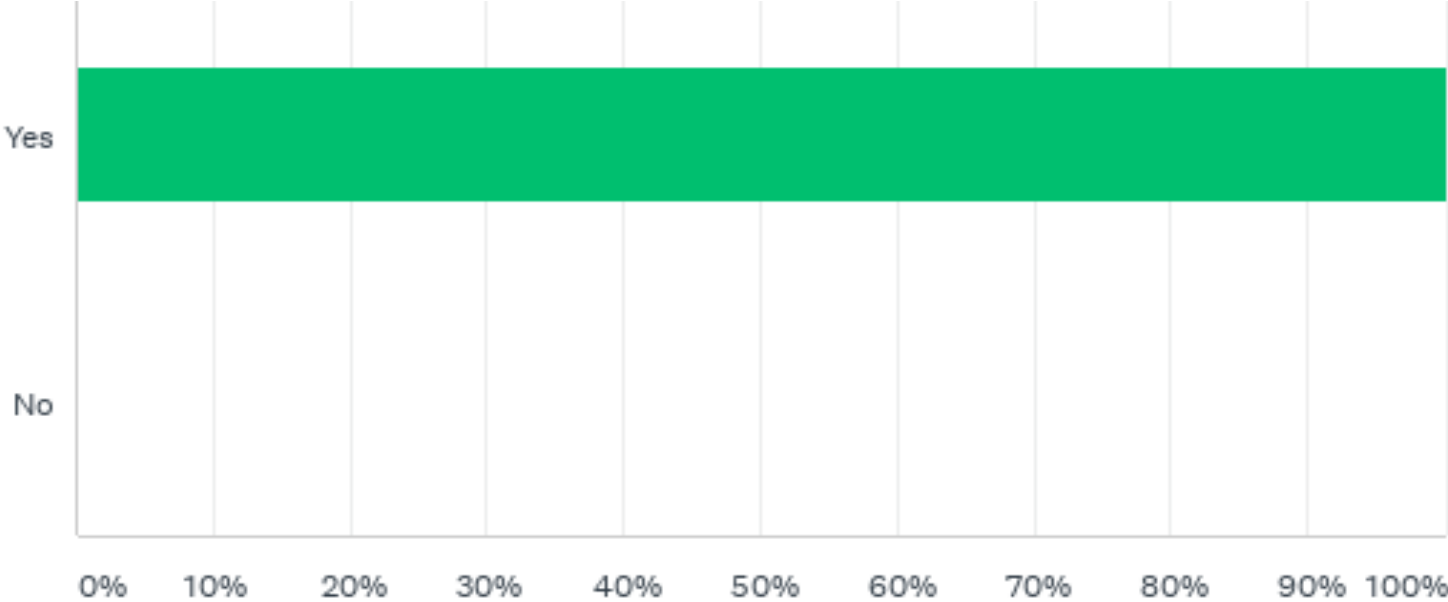
Q6: Are you concerned about the risk of seasonal flu infection?



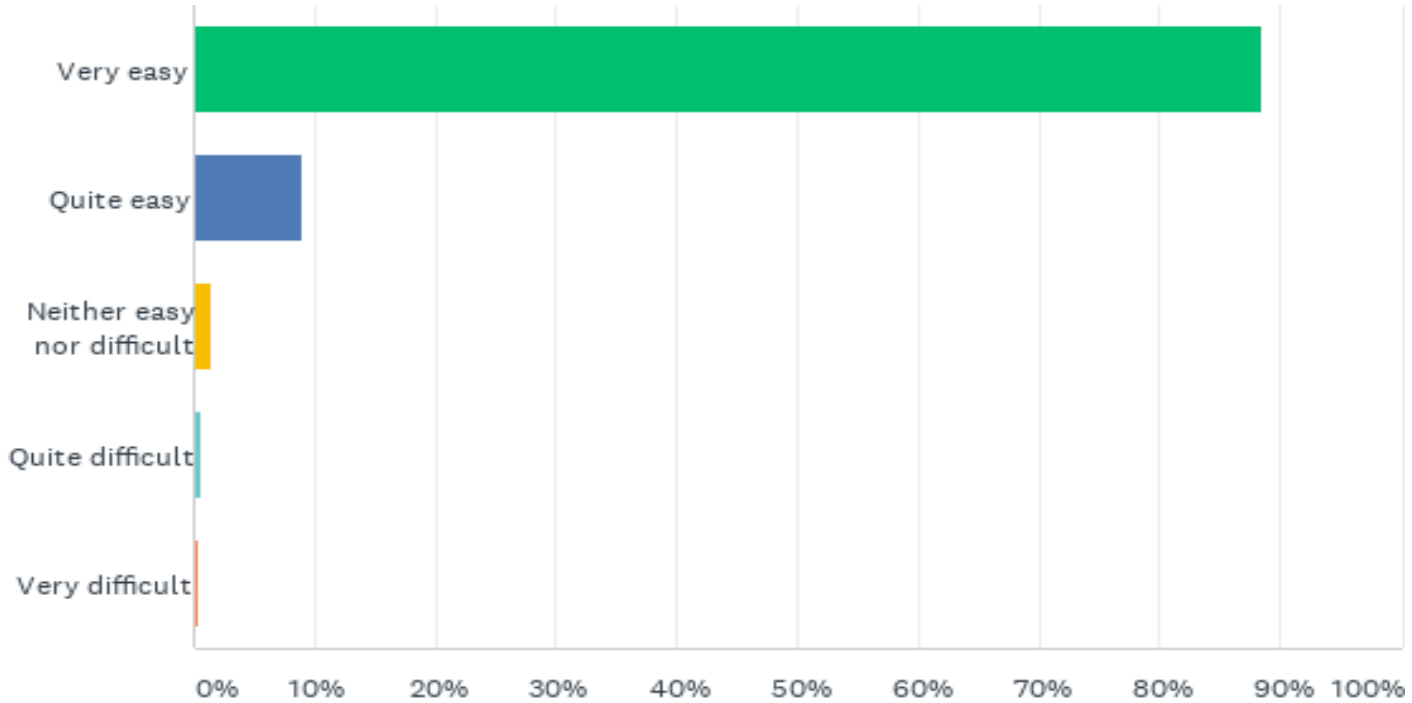
Q7: Have you or any person you care for had a seasonal flu vaccination in the past two years?



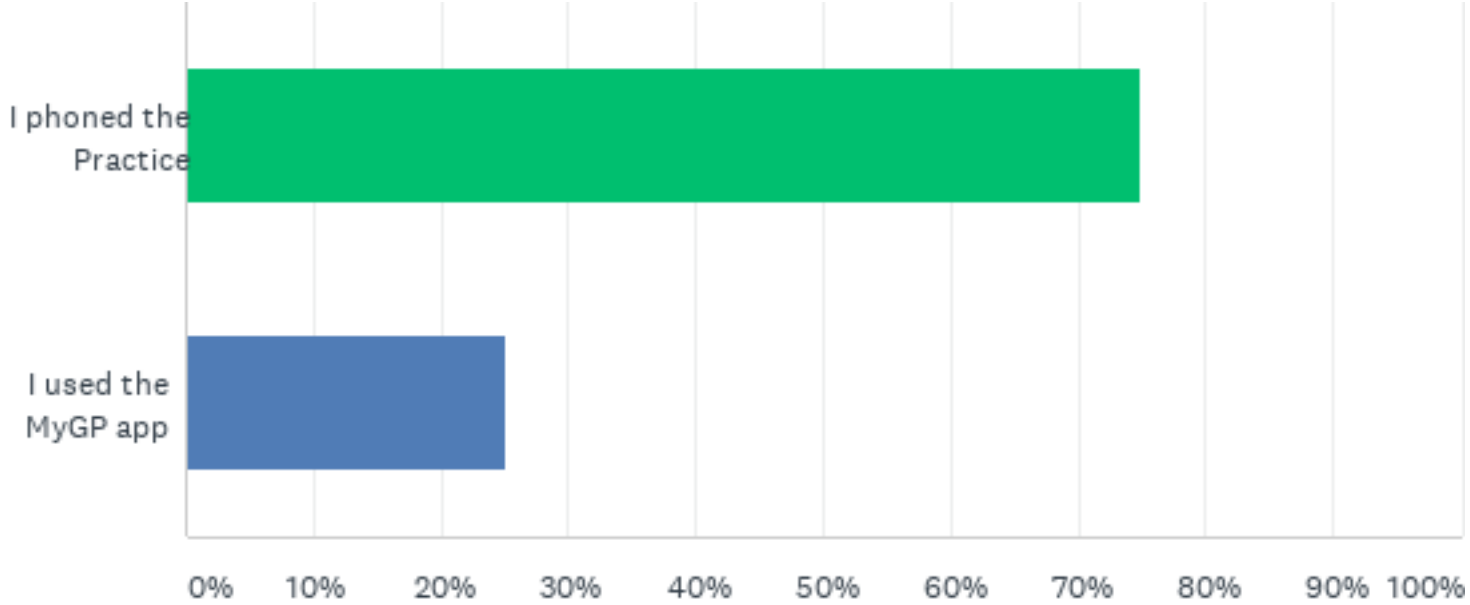
Q8: Have you already had your seasonal flu vaccination this year?



Q9: How easy was it to make your flu vaccination appointment?

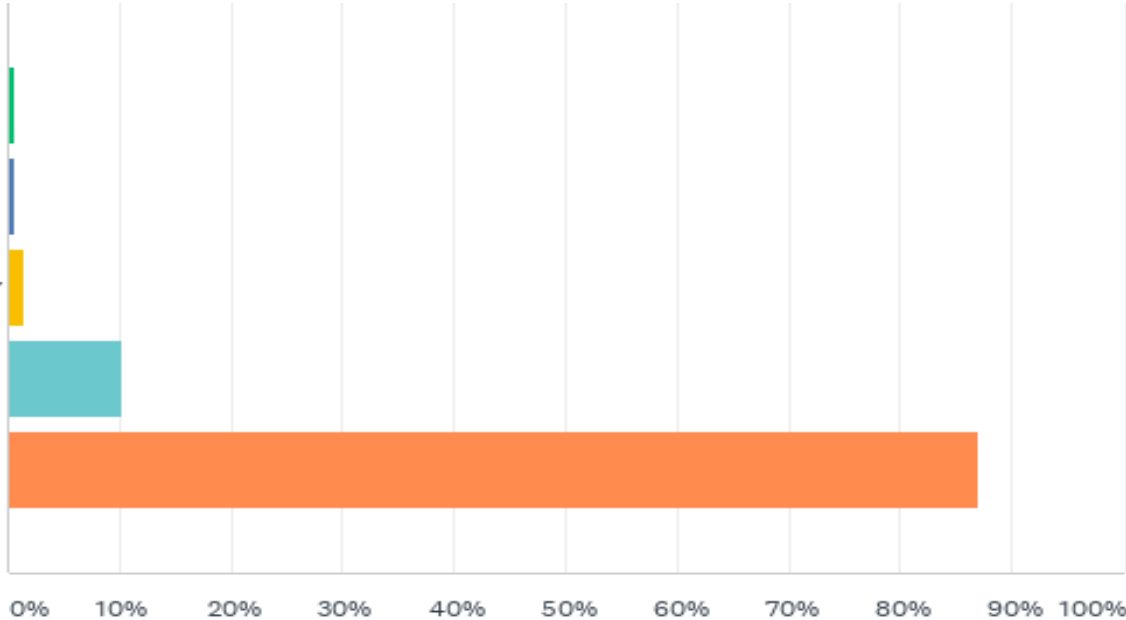


Q10: How did you make your flu vaccination appointment?

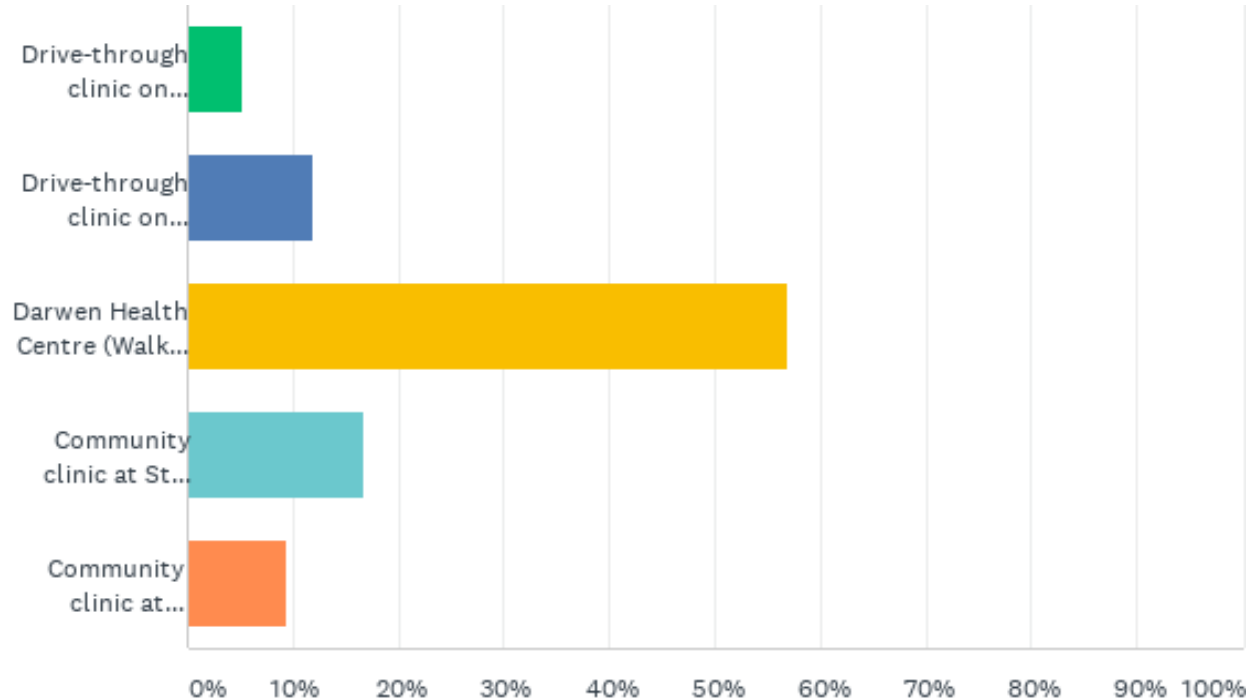

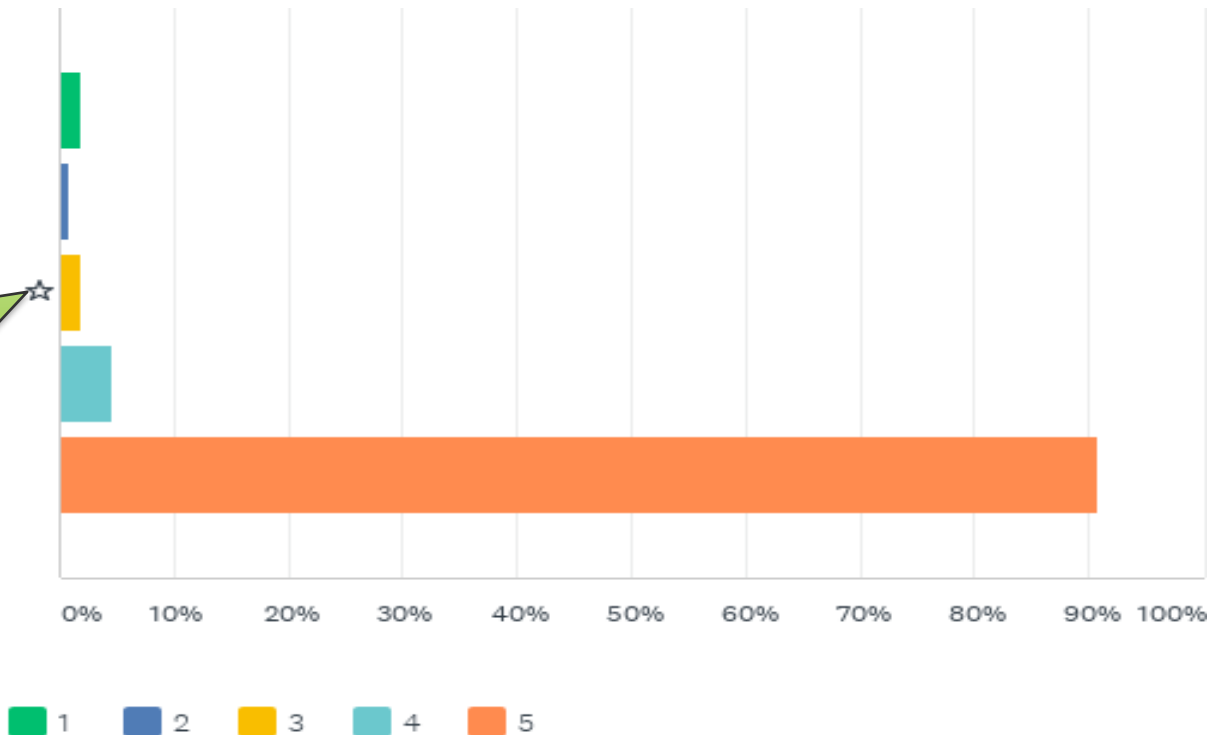

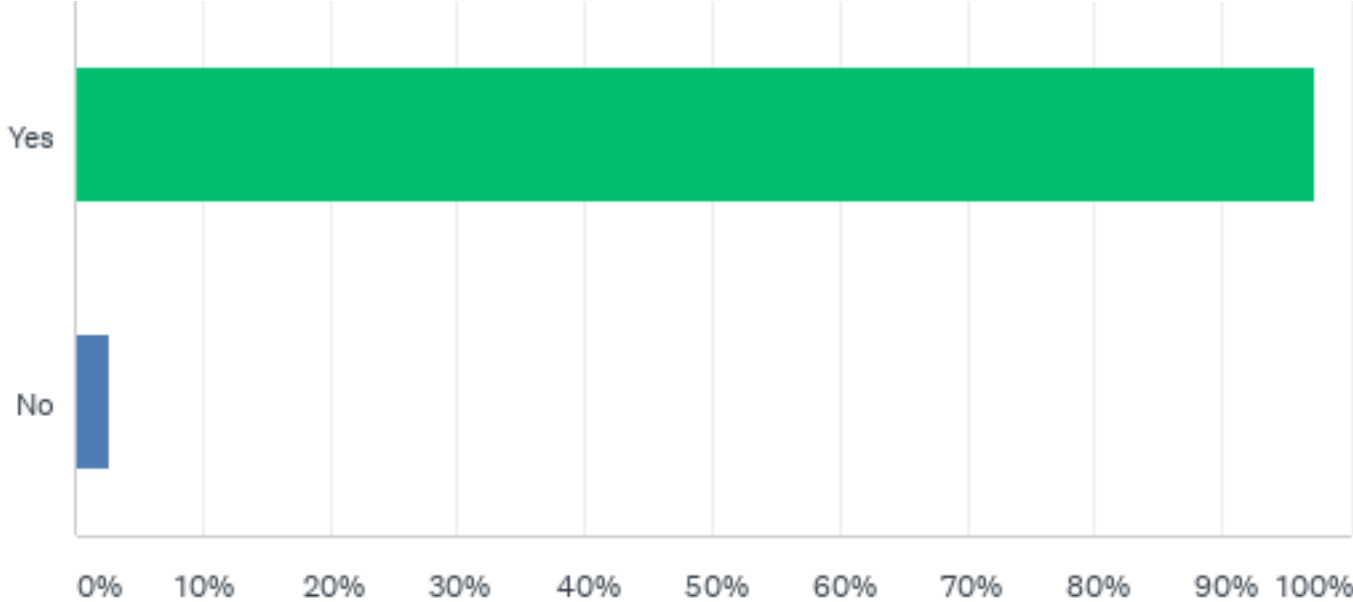


Q13: Overall, how satisfied were you with the drive-through clinic process?

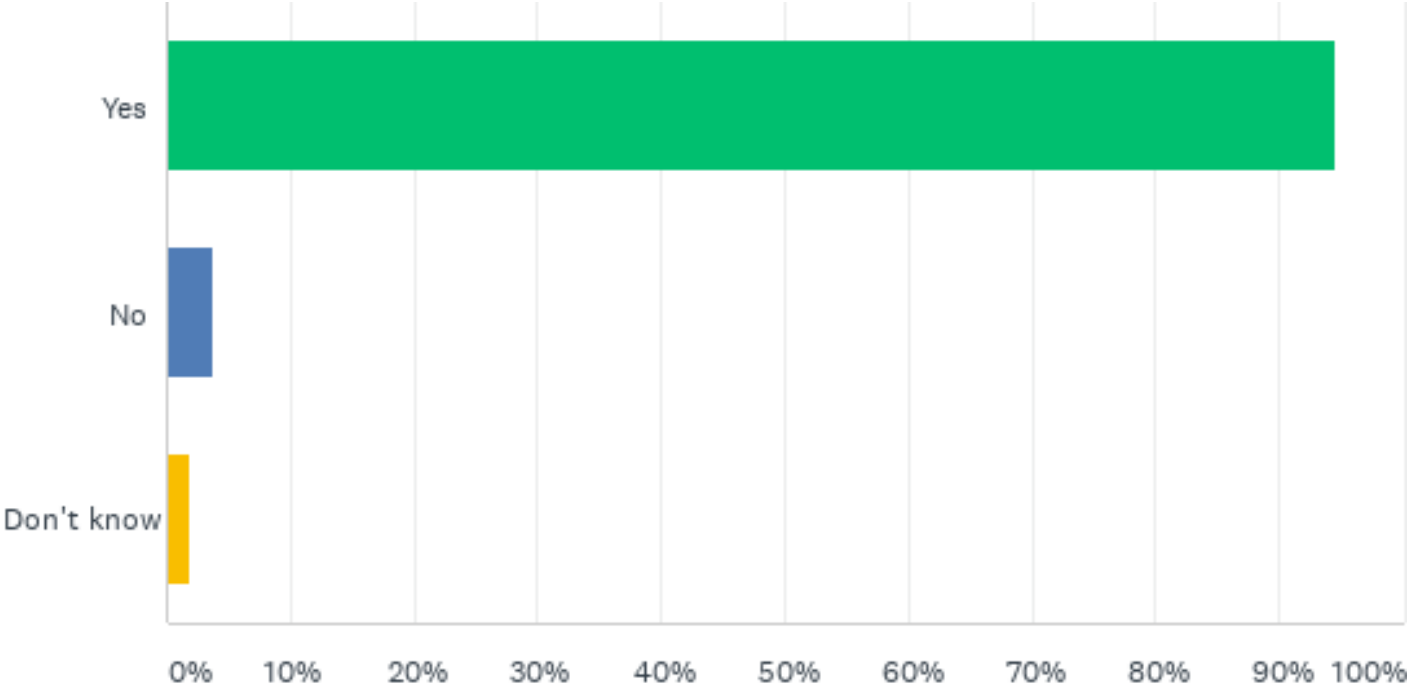

Q14: Were you seen promptly at the time of your appointment?

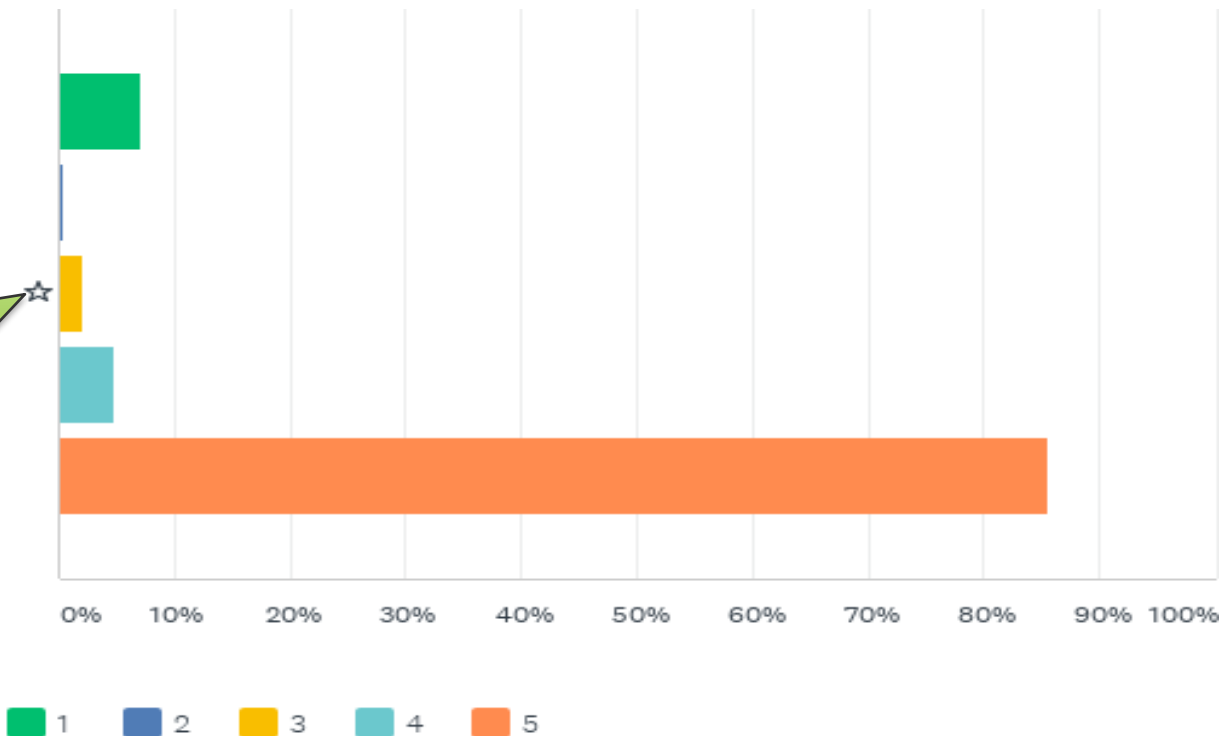


Q15: Would you use a drive-through clinic again?

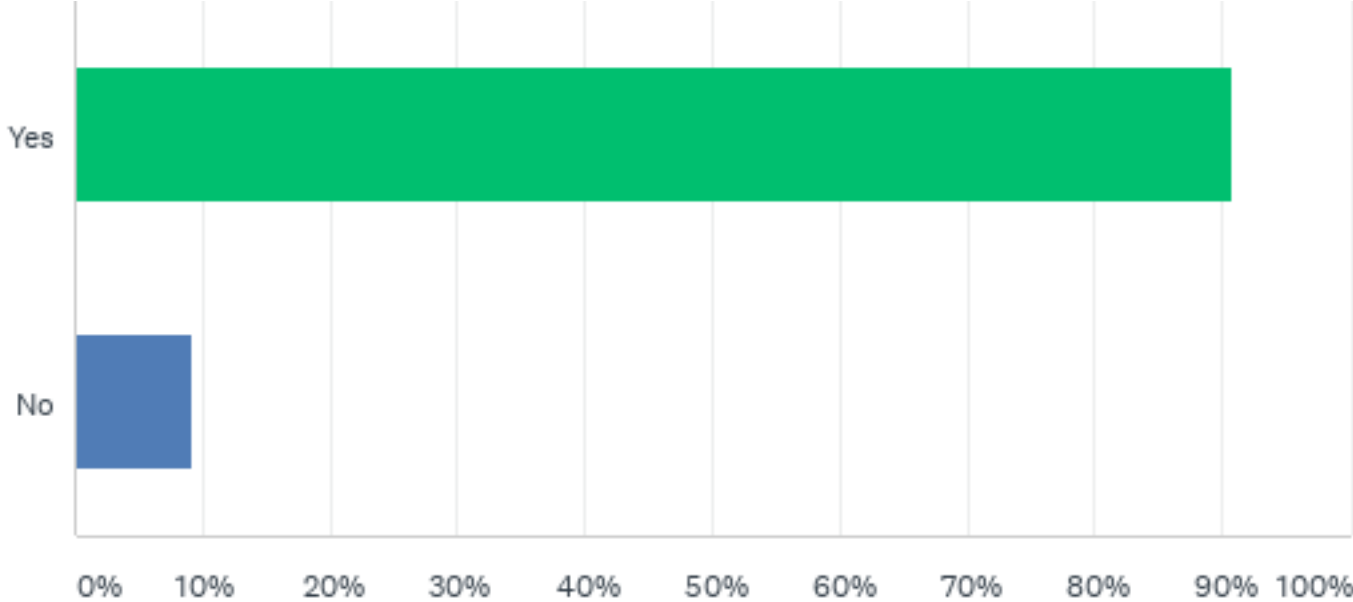


Q17: Overall, how satisfied were you with the Community Clinics process?

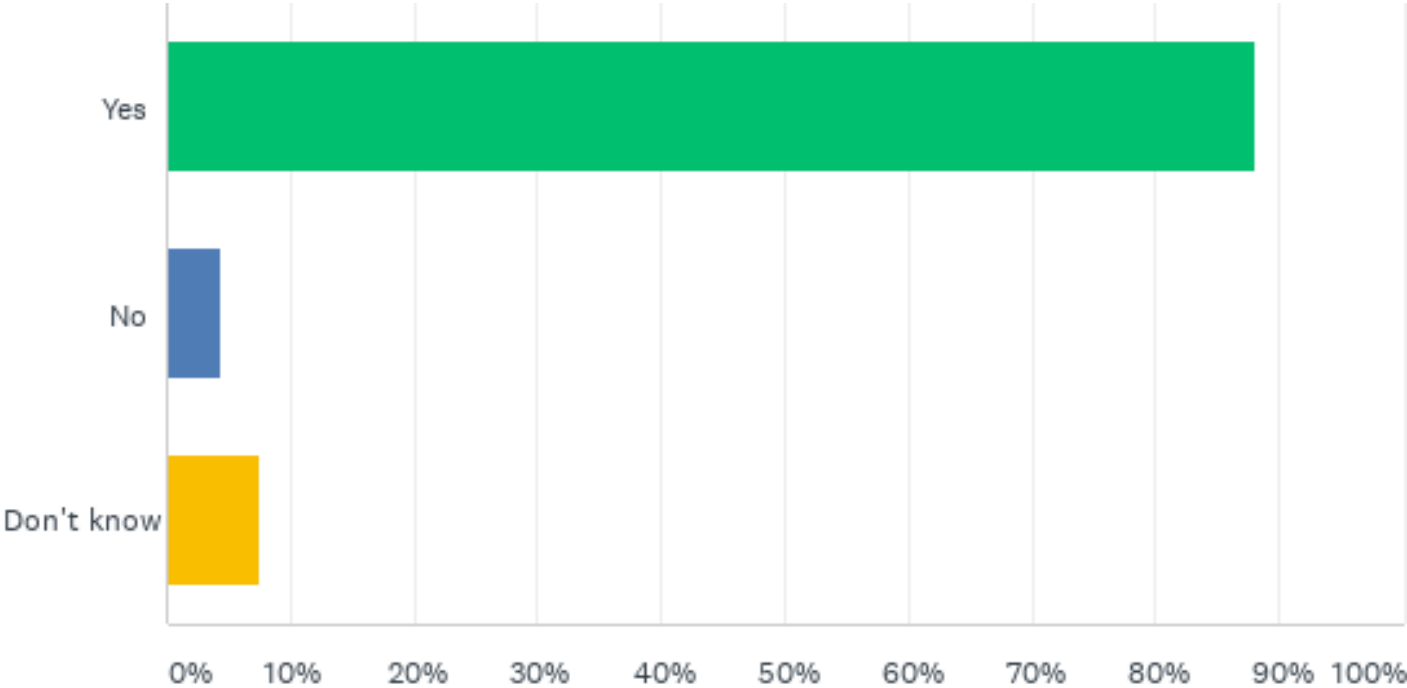

Q18: Were you seen promptly at the time of your appointment?

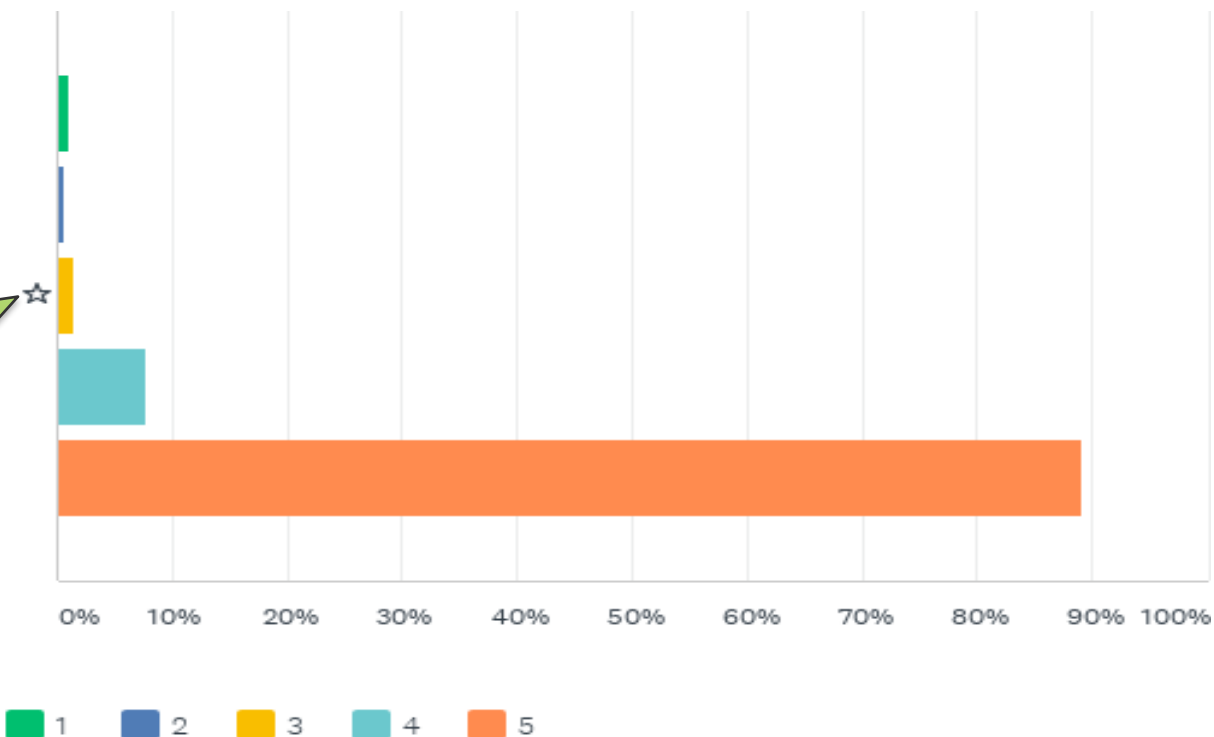


Q19: Would you use a Community Clinic again?

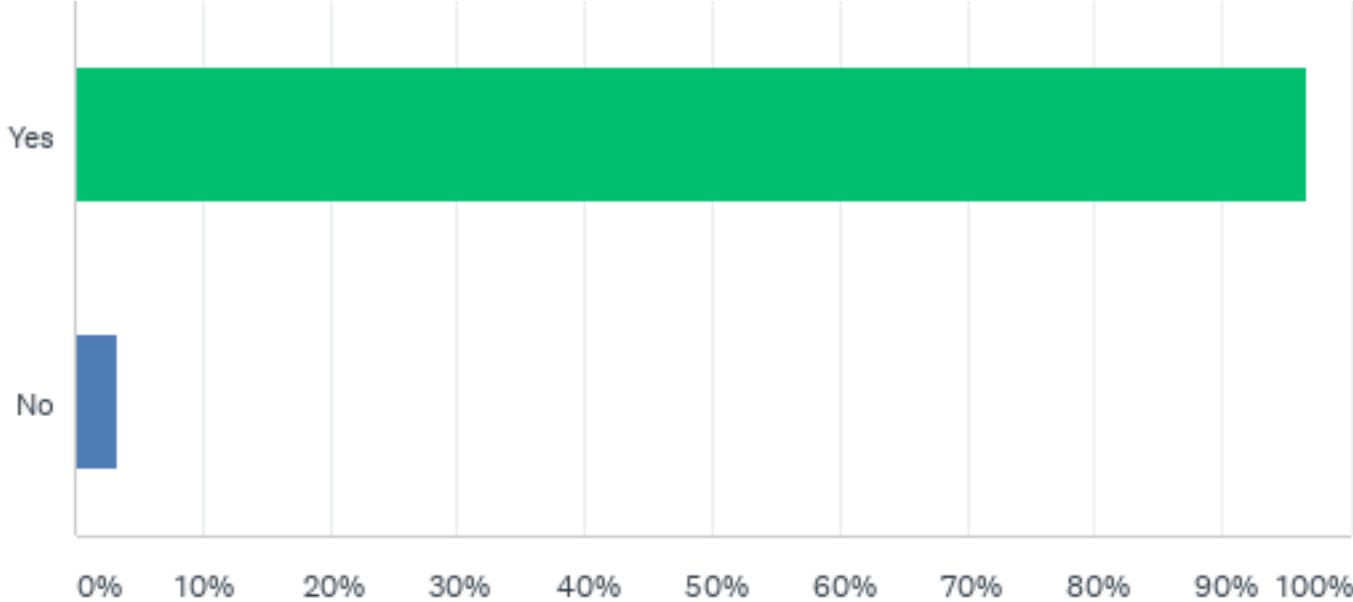


Q21: Overall, how satisfied were you with the Darwen Health Centre process?
